

Jubilee Fund and Noventis CU Partner for Social Impact in Manitoba Agreement Between Fund and Credit Union Brings Increased Access to Ethical Investment

September 11, 2021, WINNIPEG/INTERLAKE, MB. // Winnipeg-based Jubilee Fund and Noventis Credit Union are celebrating the completion of an agreement that will grow access to social impact financing and ethical investment opportunities outside of Winnipeg and throughout the Interlake region of Manitoba.

The agreement means the two organizations will work together to identify opportunities and be available to offer financial assistance to social impact projects that reduce poverty that can range from affordable housing, low-cost childcare, mental and physical well-being, community resourcing and more.

“This partnership with Noventis is going to help Jubilee bring its vision of reducing poverty across the province,” said Jubilee Fund executive director Peter Cantelon. “Noventis’ strong presence and community-minded track record from Selkirk and Headingley to the Interlake region makes them an excellent partner in this initiative and we are excited to be working with them.”

As the only Manitoba-based charitable and ethical investment fund, the Jubilee Fund has assisted dozens of mostly Winnipeg-based initiatives in its more than 21-year history. This agreement is designed to help the organization meet its provincial mandate as it seeks to extend its offerings throughout Manitoba.

“Noventis has a strong history of helping the communities it’s a part of,” said Noventis CEO Kevin McKnight. “The Jubilee Fund’s heart for poverty reduction and ethical investment lines up perfectly with our own vision of building strong community – the partnership just made sense.”

Both organizations will now actively pursue and make themselves available to poverty reduction initiatives seeking financial assistance to implement their projects.

Noventis Credit Union began in 2010 after a merger between Gimli, Riverton, Arborg and Eriksdale credit unions. Since then, they have grown to serve communities throughout the Interlake region of Manitoba as well as Headingley and Starbuck with management of more than \$1 billion in assets.
